The Pathway Evaluation Process (PEP) is a serious game on governance of Radioactive Waste Management (RWM) that has been initially developed within the SITEX-II EU project: the first PEP game was dedicated to the management of high-level radioactive waste.

The PEP methodology has the ambition to create the conditions of a fair dialogue on RWM among various pluralistic societal components, providing them with equitable opportunities to contribute to the framing of the purpose and content of the exchanges (on the same footing).

Since its creation, this PEP tool has been tested and used in different national and international contexts and the SITEX.Network is organizing a topical day to provide an opportunity to discuss about the objectives, the mechanisms, the feedbacks on its different uses and the next steps of its future development with an audience of participants that are interested by this tool of dialogue.
