

Workshop on Initial Estimation of Backend Costs for Advanced Reactors and Small Modular Reactors

•The Nuclear Energy Agency (NEA) Expert Group on Costing for Decommissioning of Nuclear Installations and Legacy Management (EGCDL) is hosting a workshop focused on initial back-end and decommissioning cost estimation for small modular reactors (SMRs) and Generation IV technologies.

• It will be the **first-ever collaborative space** where experts can tackle the unique challenges of **back-end and decommissioning cost estimation** for next-generation nuclear technologies, exploring how <u>novel fuels</u>, <u>designs</u>, and <u>waste streams reshape our traditional approaches - with the aim to inform future ideas of for work across industry and other stakeholders</u>.

• Focus will be paid to key areas such as facilitating cross-industry strategic dialogue, decoding SMR/Gen IV reactor technologies, applying critical lessons learnt, fostering earlier and meaningful conversation, navigating the regulatory landscape, along with a dedicated look at providing financial assurances and guarantees.

• The Workshop will be held in-person from 18- 20 November 2025 at the NEA Premises in Paris, France.
