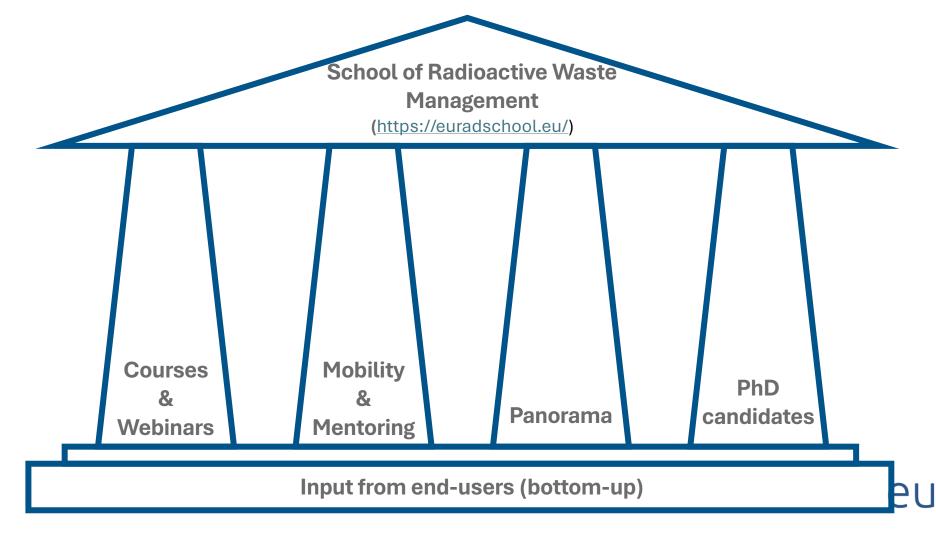


OVERVIEW OF TASK 4 – COMPETENCE BUILDING

- Matching mentor-mentee pairs (foreseen for end of 2025)



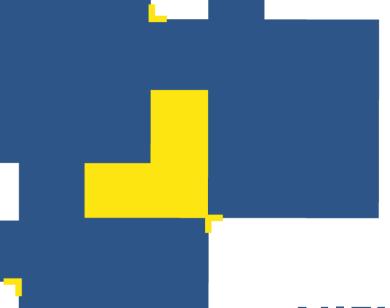
CONCLUSION AND OUTLOOK
