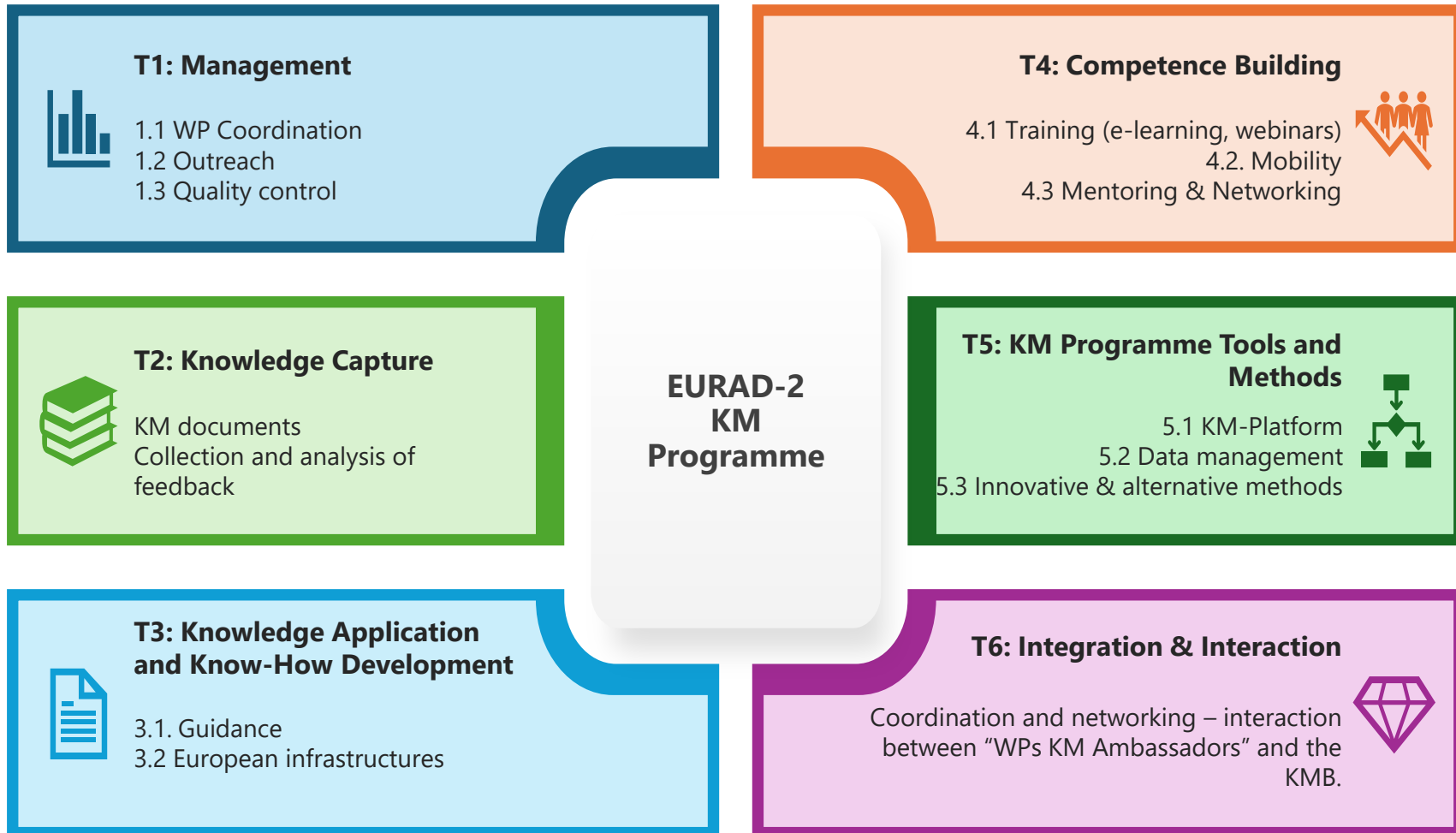

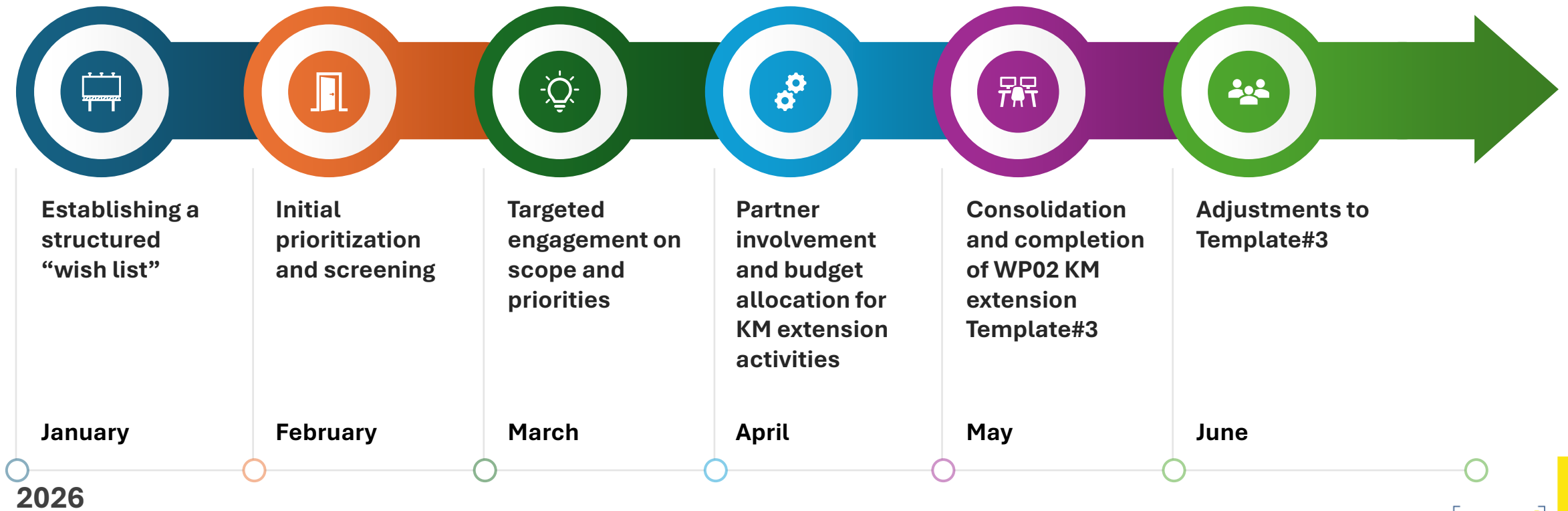

# BUILDING THE KM "WISH LIST"

Central tool → Excel-based "wish list" (All proposed KM ideas ongoing and new, standardised information)  
Bottom-up approach + structured + transparent (Milestone MS69)

## KNOWLEDGE AMBASSADORS (TASK 2 LEADERS)

- **Work Package Coordination Teams (WP CTs) for new (Wave 2) WPs will have to define roles for the KM ambassadors (also called Task 2 leaders)**
- **Role → Interface between Technical WPs and KM WP**
  - Act as primary contact point with KM Board
  - Represent KM activities within their WP
  - Prerequisite: has to be involved into the technical work not only the KM
- **Governance**
  - Participate in interactions with the KM Board
  - Option to appoint a deputy
  - The WP Coordination teams are to appoint the Task 2 Leads
- **Core responsibilities**
  - Coordination & communication
    - Coordinate KM activities within the WP
    - Ensure internal communication and engagement
  - Content & expertise
    - Identify relevant topics for KM activities
    - Propose authors and contributors
  - Quality & delivery
    - Ensure quality of KM outputs (e.g., SotA, White Papers, DI, SoK, training, etc.)
    - Support delivery of Task 2.1 & 2.2 activities
  - Integration & data
    - Align KM activities with WP objectives
    - Ensure compliance with EURAD-2 Data Management Plan

## BUDGET FOR KM ACTIVITIES

- **Total KM Budget (Years 1- 5): ~4.5 M€**
- **Key principles:**
  - Budget will be **distributed across R&D and StSt WPs** (Similarly to Wave 1)
  - **KM is intrinsically linked to technical work of EURAD-2, not standalone**
  - **KM is implemented via WP-specific Task 2 activities**
  - Ongoing discussions to define allocation and scope
- **Allocation principles:**
  - KM Ambassador: ~10%
  - Task 2.1 – (SotA, Green & White Papers)
    - R&D WPs → ~30%
    - StSt WPs → ~50%
  - Task 2.2. – KM activities (e.g. DI, SoK documents, training)
    - Allocation based on WP contribution potential; Priority topics & needs; Special calls
    - Not Pre-allocated

## TASK 3 – KNOWLEDGE APPLICATION & KNOW-HOW DEVELOPMENT CONTINUING ACTIVITIES

### • Subtask 3.1: Guidance

- Ongoing implementation of guidance and signposting to existing reference materials (from within and outside EURAD) in high needs areas (informed by Y1 survey)
- During Y3, planning to cover: 1) Transfer of experience from LIMS → SIMS; 2) Challenging wastes (SMR, organics, asbestos) (Row 19)
- Also integration of cross-cutting skills guidance (e.g. gap analysis, risk registers, SWOT,...) (Row 21)
- Targeted mid-programme refresh of stakeholder guidance needs (Y4) – will inform work in Y4/Y5 (Row 20)
- Expert & international body engagement to ensure good synergies (Row 18)

### • Subtask 3.2: RWM Infrastructures

- Annual update of RWM infrastructures list – emphasis on enhancing functionality (filtering, interactive maps,...) and building links to related infrastructure initiatives, e.g. SNETP OFFERR, SMR Alliance TWG2, JRC (Row 23)
- Long-term Sustainability of Critical RWM Infrastructures (Row 24) – build on position set out in D2.3 to identify the most critical RWM infrastructures, analyse risk and develop recommendations for long-term preservation and access
- Infrastructure Sharing & Optimisation (Row 25) – identify joint infrastructure needs across Member States and assess opportunities for sharing and co-investment

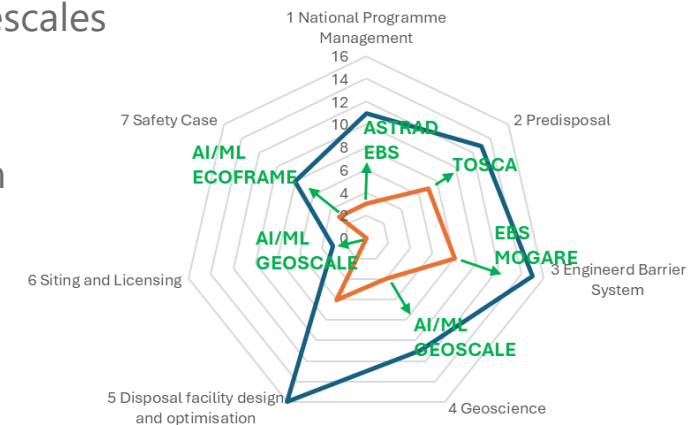
# TASK 3 – KNOWLEDGE APPLICATION & KNOW-HOW DEVELOPMENT NEW ACTIVITIES

## • Project Delivery and Knowledge Continuity over Long Timeframes (Subtask 3.1.5)

- Transfer of experience on project delivery and knowledge continuity over the long timescales involved in RWM
- Guidance and training materials drawing on case studies of good practice
- Linked to guidance topics #4 (transfer of experience from LIMS → SIMS); #6 (long-term planning & decision making); #7 (competence development)
- Support PhD to be funded (outside of EURAD-2) by BGE
- **Inputs invited from partners with expertise in building long-term resilience**

## • Subtask 3.3: Operational Safety Gap Analysis

- Identify and examine gaps and information needs relating to operational safety, to complement needs identified in the EURAD SRA
- Recommend possible activities on this topic for implementation during a future phase of EURAD
- As per discussions at GA#4 and Bureau recommendations during Wave 2 planning - links to Roadmap Themes 5.4, 7 and 6.3
- Inter-College exchange event (conference / workshop) followed by documentation of needs
- **Inputs invited for subtask lead and input of subject matter experts**



**Blue:** number of topics in the SRA for each Theme  
**Red:** number of SRA subdomains addressed by 1<sup>st</sup> wave EURAD-2 WPs for each theme (according to WP descriptions)  
**Green:** directions where 2<sup>nd</sup> wave WPs will have an impact

## TASK 4 – COMPETENCE BUILDING (ROWS 28 - 32)

- **Training development:** enhancement of LMS-hosted training content (task 4.1/4.5)
- **Mobility Programme:** expansion to include YG groups visits and mentoring-related actions (task 4.2)

- Development of advanced training courses in **collaboration with IAEA** (task 4.5)

## TASK 5 - KM PROGRAMME TOOLS AND METHODS

- ▶ Platform survival post-EURAD-2: hosting solution is an ABSOLUTE priority
  - ▶ Discoverability / transparency of all EC-funded outputs beyond project end
  - ▶ Responsible AI integration with clear governance and human oversight
- CONTINUING ACTIVITIES
    - Support to WPs on data management (FAIR principles, DMPs, metadata standards) : ProjectPlace, Zenodo, GitHub, EUSurvey.
    - Special attention to finishing Strategic Studies and information to new WP starting in Wave 2
    - Knowledge Platform implementation : improved searchability & content management
  - NEW IN WAVE 2
    - Long-term IT hosting & KM-platform sustainability: agreed hosting solution for website, KM platform and EURAD School beyond project lifetime
    - AI Use Cases for KM : map AI initiatives (IDKM, etc.); test use cases; define responsible AI policy for KM from feedback about existing guidance in partners organisations
    - Community Engagement : how to consider knowledge differently and envisage gamification of knowledge ? Involving younger generations and civil society

### **Appointment of KM Ambassadors for new Work Packages (building on Slide#10)**

The Coordinator/PMO will be sending an email request to Wave 2 WP Coordination Teams (WP CT) to identify the persons/institutes who will be the WP leader(s) and Task leaders. If you or your colleagues are interested in having the "Task 2 leader" role then please discuss with the relevant WP CTs. The KM Board will get the list of Task 2 leaders from the Coordinator/PMO in late May; there is no need for you to directly reach out to WP2 KM Board on this point. The KM Board can then help guide the Task 2 leaders of the new WPs about text and expectations (budgets) for the new WPs' Template#3 text
