Suggesting a failure idea doesn't mean you'll be the one to carry it out.

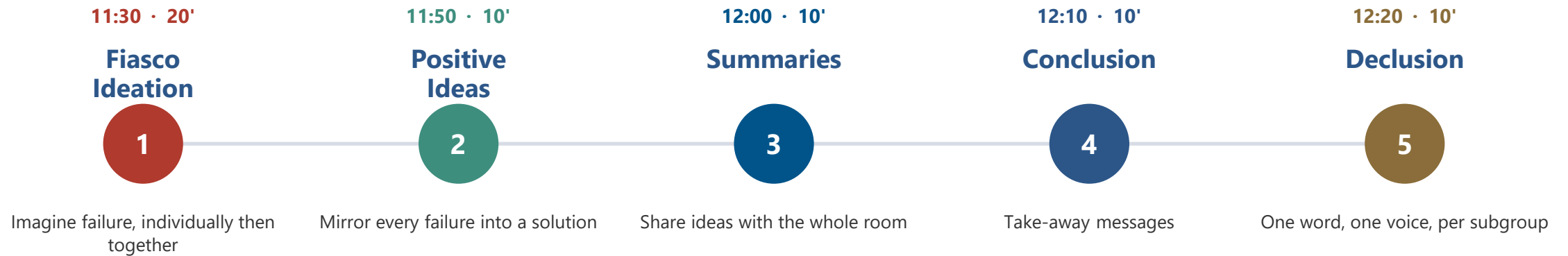

At every step, your facilitator explains what's expected before you start.

ROADMAP FOR THE NEXT HOUR



Every failure idea will be mirrored into a positive solution before we close the session.

STEP 1 — FIASCO IDEATION (20')

THE GUIDING QUESTION

"What should we do today, under evolving climate conditions, to cause a RWM facility to fail catastrophically over centuries to millennia?"

SETUP

Subgroups at their tables · Post-its per participant · Two fiasco paperboard sheets per table · Facilitator acts as scribe

5' Individual reflection

Silently write down ideas: mistakes, oversights, poor assumptions.

5' Clarify & categorize

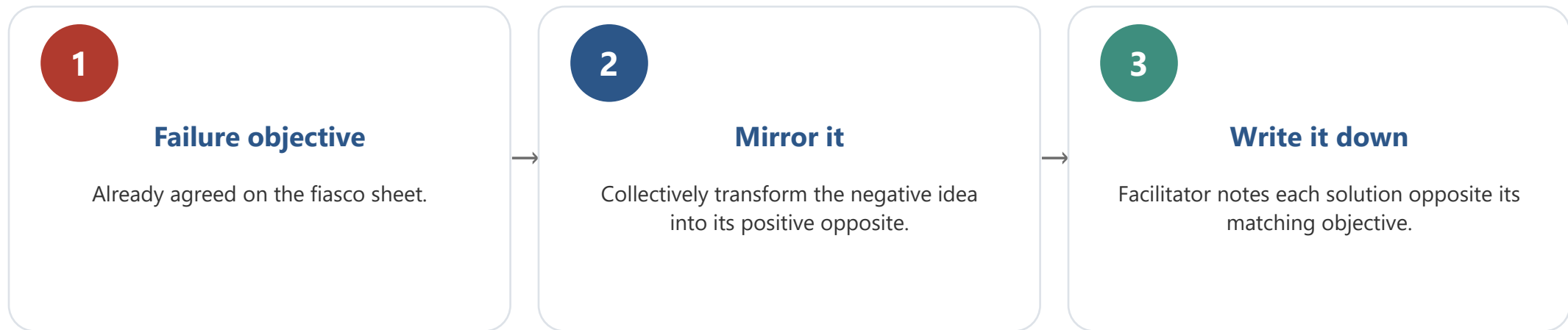
Facilitator checks ideas, confirms categories (tools, functioning, communication...).

10' Collective ideation

Group builds ideas for each failure objective; facilitator writes them on the sheet.

STEP 2 — POSITIVE IDEAS (10')

Goal: identify ideas the Consortium could actually put in place.



One or more solutions can be proposed for each failure objective — quantity is welcome here too.

STEPS 3–5 — SHARING & CLOSING (30')

Summaries

10' · Plenary

One person per subgroup shares an idea; a second round follows with new ideas.

Conclusion

10' · Plenary

The chairperson draws out the key take-away messages for the room.

Decusion

10' · Subgroups

Each subgroup agrees on one word or sentence and names a rapporteur to say it aloud.
